 - Certain verbs in the NDLOs are higher level when compared to the LOs
 - Implication it is a complete list
 - Using learning outcomes in the title
 - Implication it is describing the way to achieve the authoritative learning outcome

Remove verbs

Keep verbs with clear explanation of objective

Use the same verb as that used in the LO

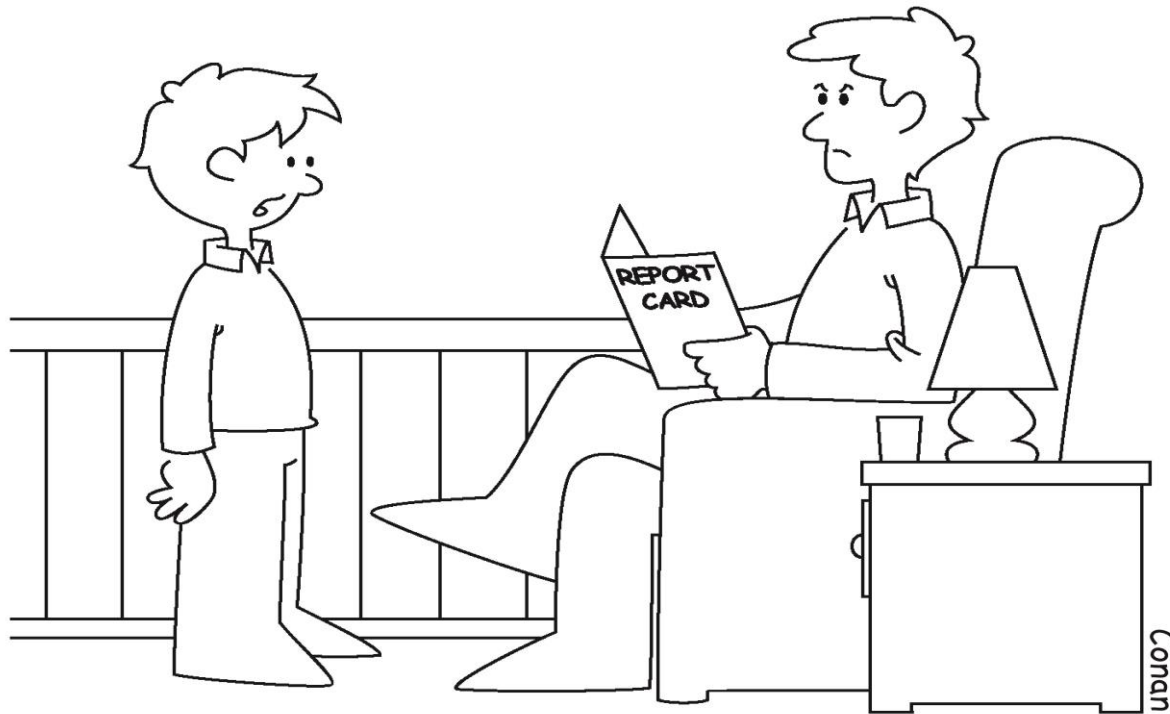
Remove verb and replace with a “fill in the blank”
